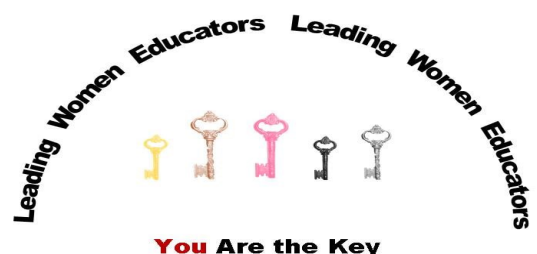

Duties of Officers:

President

- (1) act as presiding officer at regular meetings and direct the activities of the organization
- (2) act as chairman of the executive board.
- (3) appoint a parliamentarian from the membership, and appoint all standing and all special committees.
- (5) approve payments for expense claims and approve publications.
- (6) Vote at all Psi State Executive

Vice Presidents

First and Second Vice-President - shall serve as presiding officer in the absence of the president and, in the event of the resignation or death of the president, shall succeed to the presidency and serve until the next regular election of officers.

The Second Vice-President – shall serve as presiding officer in the absence of both the president and the first vice-president and, in the event of the resignation or death of either the president or the first vice-president, shall succeed to the office of first vice-president and serve until the next regular election of officers.

Recording Secretary – shall keep minutes of each meeting of the organization and furnish the president with a copy of such minutes. She shall serve as secretary to the executive board and executive committee.

Corresponding Secretary- shall carry on such correspondence delegated by the president.
